The Neuro-Oncology program is a multi-disciplinary program focusing on primary brain tumors and neuro-oncologic complications of cancer. The Vanderbilt University Clinical Neurophysiology Fellowship offers training in three tracks: epilepsy-EEG track, neuromuscular-EMG track, and mixed clinical neurophysiology track.

The epilepsy-EEG track provides in-depth training in the diagnosis, evaluation, and medical and surgical management of adult and pediatric epilepsy. Fellows will receive training in EEG, EEG-video monitoring, non-invasive and invasive presurgical evaluation, and clinical drug trials. In Addition, fellows will be sufficiently exposed to other areas of clinical neurophysiology for board certification in Clinical Neurophysiology.

The neuromuscular-EMG track provides training in EMG and neuromuscular disorders, with some exposure to EEG and epilepsy, designed to meet requirements for board certification (added qualification in clinical neurophysiology as well as ABEM certification examination).

The mixed Clinical Neurophysiology Fellowship track provides training in a broad area of clinical neurophysiology, designed to meet requirements for board certification. The training includes EEG, Epilepsy monitoring, EMG, neuromuscular disorders. There is also exposure to sleep medicine and autonomic disorders, but not in a time block. The emphasis on central versus peripheral clinical neurophysiology may vary.

The training duration is a minimum of one year (accredited training), but a second year is available for fellows interested in in-depth training in epilepsy.
